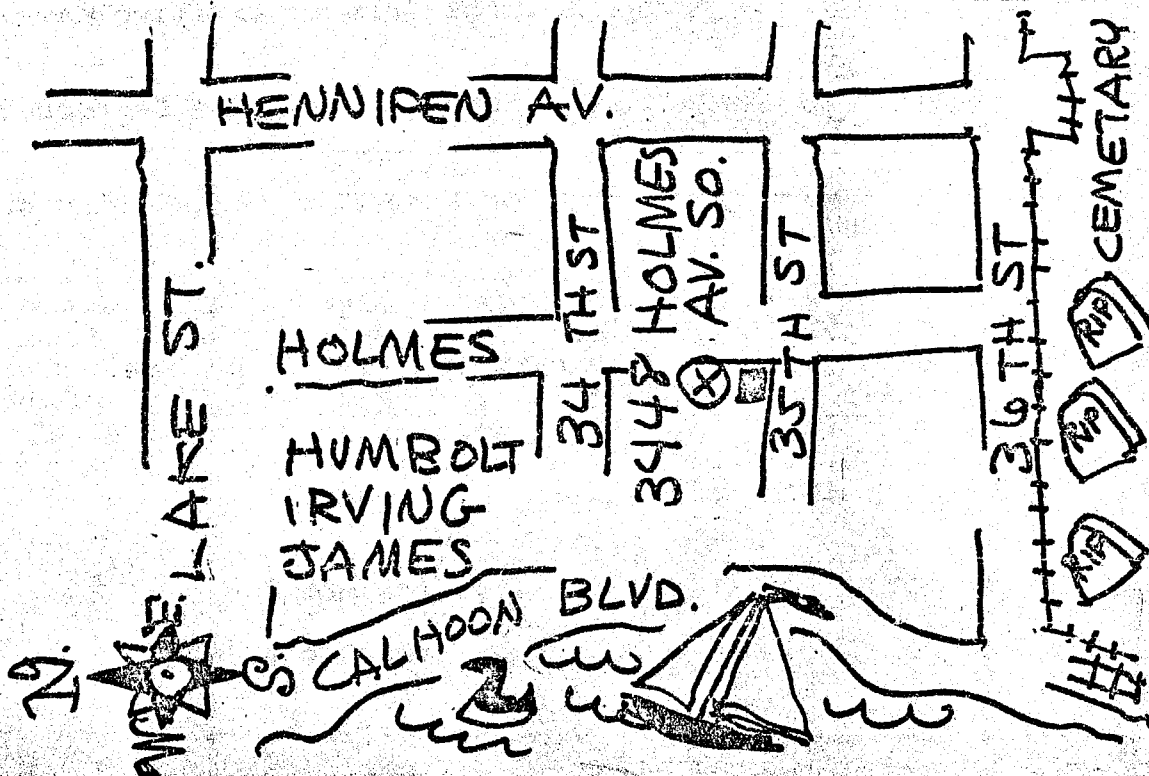


Second Annual Ball-October 8
